- * Connected elderly seniors with art through outreach to assisted living communities.



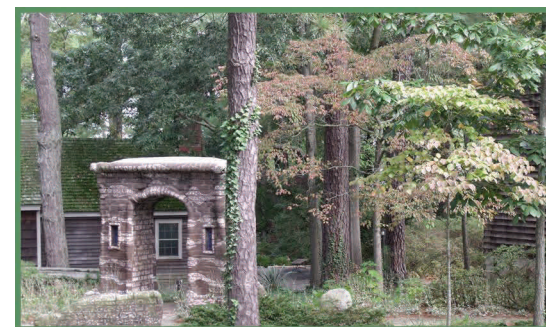
- * Offered free lectures and exhibitions that reveal the immense creativity and artistic talent in the area.

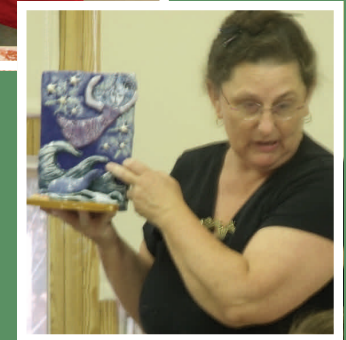
