

4th Regional Juried Exhibition

You are cordially invited to enter the Rehoboth Art League's 4th Regional Juried Exhibition. Open to all artists living in Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Virginia, West Virginia and Washington, D.C. There will be \$4,000 in prizes awarded. The competition is open to all artists, both professional and amateur.

- All entries will be juried from digital image. Each artist may enter up to two pieces of original artwork created within the past two years and never accepted into any other juried show. Only one piece of art per artist (if artist is accepted) will be juried into the show.
- All information given on the original entry as to the title, size and price must remain the same on the accepted entry.
- Any entry considered offensive or not meeting exhibition criteria may be rejected by the Exhibition Committee at its sole discretion.
- Entries must be original in concept, composition and execution. Artwork created under the supervision of an instructor is not eligible. Artwork must not be copied, in part or wholly, from any published or copyrighted work.
- Prints are not acceptable.

EXHIBITED WORKS

All exhibited works must be for sale and priced with intent to sell. Prices listed on the entry form are binding. A 30% commission to the Rehoboth Art League will be retained on all sales at the show or as a result of the show.

Best in Show: \$2000 / Juror's Awards of Excellence (3): \$500 / Honorable Mention (2): \$250

Artists whose work is accepted will receive further instructions regarding shipment or hand delivery with their notification. But please note:

- All work must be quality framed. Plexiglas must be used on all shipped 2-D work needing glazing. Only pastel pieces may be covered with glass. Artwork must be framed and ready to hang with wire and screw eyes (no saw tooth hangers). Works must fit through a 71" doorway. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Large sculpture must be delivered by the artist with appropriate display support.
- Shipped works must be sent in reusable crates.
- All accepted works must include a Prepaid Return Shipping Label.
- Late or damaged shipments will be returned collect.

Hixson has extensive museum and curatorial experience, having worked for the Fabric Workshop and Museum in Philadelphia as well as serving as Associate Curator of the Contemporary Arts Center in Cincinnati, and Curatorial Fellow in the Contemporary Art Department at the J.B. Speed Art Museum in Louisville, KY. She recently opened a Philadelphia-based gallery called The Shaft, a makeshift space that will showcase pop-up exhibitions.
